

# ORDER

For Closing of Registration Books  
before PRIMARY ELECTION  
August 7, 2018

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2311(c), notice is hereby given that on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2018, all registration books for the Primary Election will close at the end of regular business hours (5:00 p.m.). Registration books will remain closed until the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2018.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years by the next election, must register and show proof of ID and citizenship before he or she can vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law, his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one (1) of the following occurs:

1. The voter changes his or her name by marriage.
2. The voter changes residence.
3. The voter's name has been purged according to law.

If any of the above has occurred, you must re-register.
